## Water Jet Cutting Technician

- Position:** Full Time post (Probationary period of 6 months)
- Hours:** 43.5 hrs p/w (core hours Mon-Thu 8.30 – 17.30, Fri 0730 – 15.00)  
You will be required to work shifts when workload requires it (early (6am – 3pm) / evening (1pm-10pm) / night (10pm – 6am) / weekend)  
Overtime may be required.
- Pay:** Salary starting at £19,000 p.a.- dependent on experience.  
(Eligible for profit related pay on completion of probation)
- Holidays:** 2.42 days per month worked for 1<sup>st</sup> year. Thereafter 29 days per year, with one additional 'service' day per year worked, up to a maximum of three additional 'service' days.
